#### A Lenten Discipline for Good

Your Serve team invites you to accept Bishop Michael McKee's challenge to practice a Lenten discipline for good. We're asking you to:


- Fast one meal a week during Lent.
- **Pray during that mealtime** for your church, those who are hungry, and the North Texas Food Bank and its partner agencies.
- Give to the North Texas Food Bank through the Lenten offering, using the funds that would have been spent on those meals given up.

Beginning March 2<sup>nd</sup>, Lenten offering containers and envelopes will be available in the gathering area for you to take home and use as a reminder to follow the spiritual discipline. On Easter Sunday, April 20, we will dedicate our gifts to the North Texas Food Bank (NTFB).

The NTFB is not only one of our nation's largest food banks but also the lifeline to food assistance programs here in Commerce. The Food 4 Kids backpacks that go home every Friday with food-insecure elementary school children and the boxes of food that the Bread of Life Food Pantry distributes monthly come from the NTFB. Hunt County Shared Ministries - FISH in Greenville is also a NTFB partner agency.

Know that your gift will be used wisely. 93 cents of every donated dollar goes fulfilling the NTFB's mission. 7 cents goes toward administration and fundraising.

Would you like to get a behind-the-scenes glimpse into the operations of the NTFB? On Saturday afternoon, April 5, FUMC-C volunteers will go to the NTFB warehouse in Dallas to sort and box foods for distribution to partner agencies. "What if 10,000 Methodists in North Texas fasted one meal a week during Lent and gave the money saved to a local food ministry?"

Bishop Mike McKee asked this question at last summer's annual conference. What if, indeed?

What if each of us fasted one meal per week during Lent this year?

What if we each felt the insistent rumbling in our tummies telling us we're hungry? Might this be something the Spirit could use to help us grow into more faithful disciples?

What if we helped feed that rumbling with just a few more minutes of prayer time each week during Lent – say, spending seven minutes in prayerful silence once a week in our midweek Eucharist service during Lent?

What if each household in our congregation placed a Lenten devotional calendar on the fridge in the kitchen, and we each took just a minute or two to reflect on the thought for that day?

What if all this happened?

What if enough of us participated in fasting, giving, and praying that it would cause a groundswell of revival (dare we say that word?) in our community?

What if, indeed? We've got the season of Lent to find out. Will you join me?
